

**RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS FOR THE GOVERNING BODY
OF THE CITY OF CHEYENNE**

January 3, 2017

The Governing Body of the City of Cheyenne met in “Sine Die” Session on this date at 6:00 p.m. in the Cheyenne Civic Center. Those present were: MAYOR - Richard L. Kaysen; COUNCIL MEMBERS - Jim Brown, Bryan Cook, Richard Johnson, Mike Luna, Dr. Mark Rinne, Scott Roybal, Dicky Shanor, Jeff White and Annette Williams. Also present: Carol Intlekofer, City Clerk. The pledge of allegiance, led by members of the Mayor’s Youth Council, was recited.

Mayor Kaysen welcomed those in attendance and stated the purpose of the “Sine Die” session was administrative in nature to ceremonially recognize outgoing Council members for their years of service on City Council, as well as the outgoing City Council President for 2016.

At Mayor Kaysen’s request, Carol Intlekofer, City Clerk, read a ceremonial resolution in its entirety honoring outgoing Council member Jim Brown, entitled as follows: “A Resolution in Recognition of the Honorable Jim Brown for his dedication and outstanding contributions to the City of Cheyenne and its residents.” Mayor Kaysen presented Mr. Brown with a framed version of the Resolution and expressed appreciation to Mr. Brown for his 10 years of service on City Council and to the community. Mr. Brown briefly commented on his terms of service as a City Council member. (#5822)

At Mayor Kaysen’s request, Ms. Intlekofer read a ceremonial resolution in its entirety honoring outgoing Council member Annette Williams, entitled as follows: “A Resolution in recognition of the Honorable Annette Williams for her dedication and outstanding contributions to the City of Cheyenne and its residents.” Mayor Kaysen presented Ms. Williams with a framed version of the Resolution and expressed appreciation to Ms. Williams for her 4 years of service on City Council and to the community. Ms. Williams briefly commented on her term of service as a City Council member. (#5823)

Mayor Kaysen relinquished duties of the chair to City Council President Bryan Cook. Mr. Cook requested Ms. Intlekofer read a ceremonial resolution in its entirety honoring Mr. Kaysen as outgoing Mayor, entitled as follows: “A Resolution in recognition of the Honorable Richard L. Kaysen for his dedication and outstanding contributions to the City of Cheyenne and its residents.” Mr. Cook presented Mr. Kaysen with a framed version of the Resolution and also presented him with a gavel plaque depicting his 8 years of service as Mayor. Mayor Kaysen briefly commented on his 2 terms as Mayor. (#5824)

Mr. Cook then returned duties of the chair to Mayor Kaysen. On behalf of the governing body, Mayor Kaysen expressed appreciation to Mr. Cook for his leadership as City Council President for 2016 and presented him with an engraved gavel plaque. Mr. Cook briefly commented on his service as City Council President for the past year.

Mayor Kaysen announced the First Regular Meeting of the governing body involving newly elected and continuing members would convene after a musical performance by The Squash Blossoms.

There being no further business previously noted for the “Sine Die” Session and purpose of the meeting having been met, the meeting was officially adjourned at 6:23 p.m.
