

SALES TAX COMPARISON OVERVIEW

May 2023 versus May 2024 Analysis

The City's state sales tax collections payment for May 2024 was \$2,103,897 or \$39,437 more in revenue than the same time last year. On page 4, you will see a table that shows the variations by category of more than \$15,000 in sales taxes collected in Laramie County, comparing May 2023 to 2024.

The most significant sales tax differences year-over-year that are greater or less than \$100,000 are as follows:

- ↑ Power Generation and Supply. Sales tax for this industry increased by \$153,434 compared to May 2023. This industry group comprises establishments primarily engaged in generating transmitting and/or distributing electric power. Establishments in this industry group may perform one or more of the following activities: (1) operate generation facilities that produce electric energy (2) operate transmission systems that convey the electricity from the generation facility to the distribution system and (3) operate distribution systems that convey electric power received from the generation facility or the transmission system to the final consumer
- **↑** Executive, Legislative and General Government. This industry group is primarily used by governments including Laramie County to report sales and use tax collections on all vehicle purchases, except motorcycles, obtained from a Wyoming dealer. Sales tax for this industry increased by \$107,861 compared to the same time last year.
- Other General Merchandise Stores. Sales tax for this industry decreased by \$222,671 in May 2024 compared to May 2023. This industry group comprises establishments primarily engaged in retailing new goods in general merchandise stores (except department stores).
