5 GALLON CUBIC YARD

Buffalo Chip Compost

Produced from composted manure and stable bedding materials, leaves, grass clippings, and ground wood. Used to increase water holding capacity and improve soil structure when planting trees, grass, and bedding plants. Also used to top-dress existing turf grass, potted, and bedding plants and to provide soil nutrients, organics, and beneficial microbes. Use as a soil preparation for new sod and transplants into beds or pots.

*Single Grind Mulch

Wood chip mulch produced from ground brush and limbs. Use as a decorative cover around trees, shrubs, and other plants to hold in moisture and limit growth of grass and weeds.

We are available to load all bulk volume sales into open top trucks and trailers with our loader. However, the Compost Facility is not equipped with a scale, quantities are estimated based on the following:

- One cubic yard equals to approximately 40 x 5-gallons buckets.
- One leveled, standard 6.5' bed pickup truck load equals to 2.5 cubic yards.
