Reminders from your Sanitation Division!

The City of Cheyenne's Sanitation Division would like to give a few reminders during this winter/holiday season. Containers must be out on the street by 6 a.m. or the night before your pickup day (no earlier then 4 p.m.): containers need to be removed from the street no later than 12 hours after your Have a pickup. We ask that all trash be great bagged. In an instance a holiday container be blown over bagging will help the trash to season! not be scattered and avoid the homeowner the possibility of paying a scattered trash fee. Recycling material must unbagged. Plastic bags or any thin lined plastics are considered a contamination in your recycle container and a fee could be assessed. Sanitation does offer a lid lock for

one-time fee. This holiday season we would like to remind you of a few nonrecyclable items. Metallic wrapping paper, ribbons & bows, gift bags, gift labels, packing peanuts, and bubble wrap are some items to remember NOT to place in your recycle container; but bag these items and place inside your trash container. As the weather starts to get frightful! We would like to ask for patience with our drivers on your pickup days as road conditions sometimes delay our drivers due to ice and snow. If think you may have been missed by the end of your pickup day; please call the Sanitation Division at 307-637-6440 and we will verify through our trucks video system, the reason why it may have been
