Reminders

- Watch for a letter in the mail about your new yard waste pickup day or call to verify your new day!
- Holiday pickups are now on a slide schedule everyone will slide to the next day if a holiday falls any day before or on your scheduled collection day
- Bag all trash
- 2 feet around and In between containers at curb or alley
- Cut/break down cardboard to 2' x 2'

Dates to

April 4 – Recycle Coach updates yard waste schedule (app may need to be deleted and reinstalled to see changes)

April 7 – Yard waste collection begins

April 17 – Branch pickup (call to schedule)



What can and cannot be in your yard waste container

Can:

- Lawn trimmings
- Leaves
- Weeds
- Pine needles
- Pinecones

* Please place items inside container as is – NO bagging

Cannot:

- Branches (Compost Facility)
- Tumbleweeds (Compost Facility)
- Dirt (Compost or Landfill)
- Rocks (City Landfill)
- Sod (Compost Facility)
- Bags (including paper lawn bags)
- Mulch (City Landfill)
- Trash

Springing back into yard waste

The Sanitation Division will begin our NEW Yard Waste collection schedule starting April 7, 2025. Residents should receive a letter in the mail explaining their new pickup day for yard waste. If you do not receive a letter by March 24, 2025, please give the sanitation office a call at 307-637-6440 and we will let you know the new pickup day for your address! These collections will also fall under the slide schedule during a holiday week. For example, a holiday that falls on a Monday will result in Monday collection moving to Tuesday, Tuesday to Wednesday, Wednesday to Thursday, and Thursday to Friday. Branch pickup will begin April 17, 2025, and continue to be on the third Thursday of each month during the yard waste program. This service is free to current residents enrolled in the yard waste program up to 1 cubic yd

of branches. An additional fee will be assessed for anything over 1 cubic yd. Residents who are not currently enrolled can still participate in the branch pickup for a fee. The compost Facility is located at 3714 Windmill Rd. is open to the public Tuesday – Saturday 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. residents are able to bring branches, grass clippings, weeds, leaves, tree trunks less than 6 feet in length and less than 10 inches in diameter, and manure. Please DO NOT bring mulch, stump grindings, root balls, or roots to the compost facility. These items will not be accepted; you may bring them to the City Landfill for disposal. The Yard Waste program is an optional service provided by the city and is not included in our special attention program. Anyone on special attention will need to make arrangements to have their yard waste containers out on the street by 6 a.m. the day of their pickup.
