Facility Rules

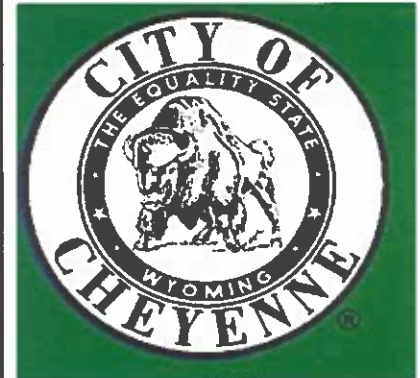
- Report inappropriate activity.

YARD WASTE CURB-SIDE COLLECTION PROGRAM

PUT YARD WASTE IN ITS PLACE

PROGRAM DETAILS

- The Program runs the first full week of April thru the 3rd week of November.
- If your regular trash collection occurs on the same day as your green waste collection, materials for green waste collection should be clearly separated from refuse collection materials. The green waste container will have the green lid.
- Call the City of Cheyenne Sanitation Division (307) 637-6440 with any additional questions that you may have regarding this service. Again, thank you for your participation.

BRANCH PICK UP

- Do not place branches, limbs, tumbleweeds or brush in your yard waste container. Up to one cubic yard may be scheduled for pickup on the third Thursday of each month by calling 307-637-6440. Place the items neatly at the front curb— do not tie. Alley pickup is not available. There is an additional charge for this service.



CONTAINER PLACEMENT



Carts must be at least two feet away from any vehicle or other obstacle (mailbox, tree, fence, driveway edge if blocked, etc.,) In the event vehicles are parked in the street, place the cart at least two feet away from the vehicle and two feet from the curb.



WHAT MATERIALS ARE ALLOWED INSIDE CONTAINER?

These materials must be loose/not bagged in the container.

- Lawn trimmings
- Weeds
- Leaves
- Pine needles
- Pinecones

WHAT MATERIALS ARE NOT ALLOWED INSIDE CONTAINER?

- Branches (Compost Facility)
- Tumbleweeds (Compost Facility)
- Bags (including paper yard bags) (Bagged compost can be emptied at the Compost Facility)
- Mulch (City Landfill)
- Sod (Compost Facility)
- Rocks (City Landfill)
- Trash (City Transfer Station or Landfill)
- Other items not included in the above list
