

PUBLIC SERVICES COMMITTEE MINUTES

A meeting of the Public Services Committee was held on Monday, March 3, 2025, in Committee Room 104 and via electronic meeting, starting at 12:00 p.m. Those in attendance were as follows:

AGENDA ITEMS

10. ORDINANCE –3rd READING – Repealing the provisions for the Paid On-Street Parking Districts program of the Municipal Code of the City of Cheyenne, Wyoming, further amending the regulatory authority governing parking in Cheyenne and abrogating any On-Street Parking District designated by Resolution of the Governing Body.

Dr. Aldrich moved to approve on 3rd and final reading, seconded by Dr. Emmons. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Dr. Aldrich, sponsor of the item, advised no further changes or recommendations have been received since approval on 2nd reading at the meeting of the governing body on February 28, 2025.

11. ORDINANCE –3rd READING – Amending Sections 1.4.4, 5.1.4 and 5.7.10, of the Unified Development Code to remove the land use term ‘Work Camps’ and prohibit their establishment within the City.

Dr. Aldrich moved to approve on 3rd and final reading, seconded by Dr. Emmons. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Charles Bloom, Planning & Development Department Director, provided a staff report and advised there have been no changes or recommendations since approval on 2nd reading at the meeting of the governing body on February 28, 2025.

14. RESOLUTION – Certifying the Cheyenne Parks and Recreation Master Plan 2025 for the City of Cheyenne and the Cheyenne Urban Area. (SPONSORS – MR. ESQUIBEL AND MR. SEGRAVE)

Dr. Aldrich moved to adopt, seconded by Dr. Emmons. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Jean Anderson-Shrednik, Parks & Greenway Planner, provided a staff report and introduced Anna Laybourn, Principal-in-Charge, and Ashley Hejtmanek, Project Manager, from Design Workshop. Ms. Laybourn provided an overview of the plan including the process, goals and action items. Chairman Segrave and all members of the committee commented on the item and thanked staff and the consultants for their work on the plan. Public comment was made by Melissa Leget.

There being no further items for the agenda to come before the Public Services Committee, the meeting was adjourned at 1:53 p.m.
